## Putting Maulden on the map

'Musings from Maulden' is a year of reflective observations from the Bedfordshire village of that name which aim to put Maulden on the map. Its author, Richard Farquharson has a knack of discerning the sacred amongst the secular.

In the course of a year, he muses on what he sees around him: God at work in His world. This refreshing book – diary, travelogue,

personal jotter – is set against the background of village life and travels further afield, as we journey with Richard through a kaleidoscope of English landscapes. It reflects changes taking place - such as the closure of his village post office, the departure of the Rector, the enthronement of the new Archbishop - in a text interwoven with the natural world, the cycle of the seasons and the Scriptures. Richard also gives tantalising glimpses into monastic life (he runs websites on behalf of the Community of the Resurrection and two other Anglican Religious Communities) and has an eye for detail as the liturgical

calendar unfolds throughout the year. Richard Farquharson lives in the village of Maulden (hence the book's title) and is active in his local church.
